

HONOR YOUR FATHER AND MOTHER

Exodus 20:12

Covenant is a beautiful word. God made a covenant with Israel, and in that covenant, he gave the ten core commandments that shape his people's relationship with him, and their relationship with each other.

The sequence of the commandments plays a vital role. The middle commandment is *honor your father and your mother*. This commandment is the link between our relationship with God and with each other. Consider this, it is from our parents that we learn about God, and it is from our parents that we learn how to interact with other.

However, this commandment is much more than a commandment for young children and teenagers to obey their parents, it is a commandment for grown children to honor their aging parents. Both Jesus and the Apostle Paul applied the fifth commandment in this way. **1 Timothy 5:8** *But if anyone does not provide for his relatives, and especially for members of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.*

Woven into the relationship between believers and their children is a covenant. This covenant begins by acknowledging that God is the giver of life and he has blessed believing parents with the gift of children. The covenant continues as the believing parents bless their children by providing what they need to mature into covenant-keeping adults. This includes love, care, and to raise their children to know they were created to be in a relationship with God and God's people. However, the covenant between parent and child does not end when the child becomes an adult. Rather, it shifts. It continues to shift as the parents age. For just as the child once needed love and care, a time comes when the aging parents will need love and care from their grown children.
