

THE LORD'S GLORIOUS HOLINESS

In the year that King Uzziah died

*"Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts;
the whole earth is full of his glory!"*

Isaiah 6:3

King Uzziah is dead and Judah is entering a time of turbulent transition. Isaiah's first response to this turbulent transition is to go to the temple and worship the LORD. That's faith.

During this time of worship Isaiah grasps the reality of the majesty and the might of the LORD God Almighty. Isaiah witnesses how the mighty angels, the Seraphim, behave in the presence of the LORD. The powerful Seraphim cover their faces and their feet. These are acts of humble worship to the LORD. And Isaiah hears the words of worship the Seraphim speak. *Holy, Holy, Holy, is the LORD of hosts.* The very essence of the LORD is holiness.

And the Seraphim keep on speaking. They keep on worshipping the LORD. The LORD's holiness is glorious. And the LORD's holiness is not limited to the heavenly temple where the Seraphim are. The LORD's holiness is not limited to the temple in Jerusalem. The LORD's holiness fills the earth, and it is glorious.

How does the earth respond to the proclamation of the Seraphim? **Isaiah 6:4** *And the foundations of the thresholds shook at the voice of him who called, and the house was filled with smoke.* That's a hearty **Amen**.

How does Isaiah respond to the proclamation of the Seraphim? **Isaiah 6:5** *And I said: "Woe is me! For I am lost; for I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts!"* That's a national confession of sin, and it's a personal confession of sin.

How will the LORD respond to those who confess their sin? **Isaiah 6:6-7** *Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a burning coal that he had taken with tongs from the altar. And he touched my mouth and said: "Behold, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away, and your sin atoned for."*

Confession of sin brings glory to the LORD. And when the LORD cleanses those who confess their sins, his glorious holiness is poured out on the earth.
