### THE PRAISE OF GOD

"I have sinned; yet honor me now before the elders of my people and before Israel..." (1 Samuel 15:30).

Saul was correct. He had sinned by disobeying God's command to destroy the Amalekites (1 Samuel 15:1-9). But his apology shows his true colors: concern for his own reputation. He had more concern for the political consequences of his actions (he is king, after all) than for the consequences in his relationship with God.

Saul's repentance seems superficial. Yet it forces us to ask ourselves, "Do we love the praise of men or the praise of God?" Have you bent your convictions to match the situation around you? Do you value public prayer more than private prayer? Are you more generous when there are eyes watching?
